Stage 1	1. I can answer 'who', 'what' and 'where' questions from a picture stimulus.
	2. I can explain what is happening using pictures.
	3. I can find an object by attribute or description, such as its colour, size, texture, shape or quantity. e.g. Can you find something red? What shape is this?
	4. I can describe an object, action or feeling (e.g. someone is "sad". Is that good or bad? Positive or negative?)
	5. I can finish a sentence that involves a new word from the story (e.g. I use a clock to tell the _____).
Stage 2	1. I can predict events. e.g. What will happen next?
	2. I can summarise events. e.g. What happened?
	3. I can deduce characters' emotions. e.g. How does the character feel?
	4. I can define a word. e.g. What does this word mean?
	5. I can identify similarities to your own experiences. (e.g. Can you think about a similar event in the story/your life?)
Stage 3	1. I can justify a prediction.
	2. I can identify why an event happened.
	3. I can infer characters' feelings and decisions.
	4. I can use new vocabulary from the text in a different context.
	5. I can suggest an alternative ending/how would you change the story? (e.g. what would you do if you were this character?)
